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Customer Spotlight

Joint Base San Antonio

We are excited to celebrate and spotlight our great clients at Joint Base San Antonio! We have been supporting the men and women of JBSA since 2005!

On Nov. 9, 2005, President George W. Bush endorsed the recommendations of the Base Realignment and Closure Commission (BRAC) and signed them into law. One of the recommendations called for the implementation of joint basing. Joint basing involved a single entity that managed the support functions of two or more adjacent Department of Defense installations. The commission felt that combined support functions eliminated duplicated efforts and created a single efficient organization. For San Antonio, the commission recommended joint basing for the three major installations around the city; Fort Sam Houston, Lackland AFB, and Randolph AFB, to form what is the largest joint base in the DOD. On Aug. 1, 2009, the Air Force activated the 502d ABW to perform the vital joint base support mission. Because of its central location in San Antonio and Bexar County, Texas, the Air Force activated the wing at JBSA-Fort Sam Houston.

The wing gradually built its staff over the next few months, while it coordinated with the support functions at Fort Sam Houston, Lackland AFB, and Randolph AFB, in anticipation of JBSA achieving Initial Operational Capability (IOC). When IOC occurred, the 502d ABW assumed responsibility for the installation support mission. On Jan. 31, 2010, the 502d ABW became the host unit at Lackland, and Randolph from the 37th Training Wing and 12th Flying Training Wing, respectively, and on April 30, 2010 the wing became the host unit at Fort Sam Houston and Camp Bullis in northwestern Bexar County. The U.S. Army Garrison at Fort Sam Houston remained active alongside the 502d MSG until JBSA achieved Full Operational Capability (FOC) Oct. 1, 2010. At FOC, the garrison inactivated.

The Air Force is the lead agency for Joint Base San Antonio, comprising three primary locations at JBSA-Fort Sam Houston, JBSA-Lackland and JBSA-Randolph plus 8 other operating locations and more than 200 mission partners.

The Air Force established the 502nd Air Base Wing to provide installation support across all JBSA locations and its Air Force commander also serves as the JBSA commander. There are 49 installation support functions to include security forces, civil engineering, manpower, personnel, services, morale/welfare/recreation, comptroller, communications, legal, equal opportunity, public affairs, chapel, logistics, contracting, & safety.

JBSA services more DOD students than any other installation, more active runways than any other installation, houses the DOD's largest hospital and only level one trauma center, supports more than 250,000 personnel, including 425 retired general officers, and interfaces with 1,000 civic leaders of San Antonio, 20 smaller communities, four counties and four Congressional Districts. Its total plant replacement value is about 10.3 billion with an annual budget of \$800 million. Despite its uniqueness in setup, the 80,000 members who belong to JBSA are making a difference, not only in San Antonio, but for the nation...accomplishing diverse training, flying, medical, cyber, intelligence and installation missions every day.

4Clicks Technical Support: Tips & How To

How Do I Alter the Unit Cost of an RSMeans® Line I tem by a Percentage?

In e4Clicks™, RSMeans® line items must be turned into **custom line items** if you want to make changes to any of the values that ultimately make up the RSMeans® published unit cost (like the material, labor, equipment and any other cost).

NOTE: The exception to this is the CCI and the O&P pricing. If you apply either of these RSMeans® published and supported adjusting elements, then the line item will be able to stay as a standard line item.

The steps below will show you how to turn your chosen line items into custom line items and indicate the pricing changes (by percentage) that you want to make, all in one batch process.



- 1. Open your estimate (**Updating Estimate** window) so that you are on the Line Items tab.
- 2. Tag the line items that you want to change.
- 3. Access the batch modify process by using Ctrl+M on your keyboard (or Right Click on any line item and then choose Process Tagged Line Items → Batch Modify Line
- 4. On the Batch Modify Line Items window, click on the Custom Guide tab to bring it forward.
- 5. On the **Custom Guide** tab: (See Figure 1)
 - A. First, locate and mark the check box next to Change Guide Type to CUSTOM.
- B. Next find the fields Material, Labor, Equipment, Total. They each represent a type of cost that may be part of the unit cost for the line items that you have tagged. Each has an empty field next to it. Use only the fields that you need. Indicate how much you want to mark up or down a specific value (by percentage) for the tagged line items by inputting a number.
- 6. Click on the Process button on the Batch Modify Line I tems window when you're ready to make the change.
- 7. Back on the **Line Items** tab (**Updating Estimate** window) the line items processed will now be custom line items. When you highlight one of them, the Guide Details panel (lower, right, corner) will tell you it's a custom line item. (See Figure 2)

Hypothetical Uses for this process:

If you have owner furnished material and want to remove the cost for materia the "Change guide type to CUSTOM" box, then enter -100.00% in the "Mate field then click the "Process" button.

If you want to decrease the cost of your labor value by 20.00%, check the "Changguide type to CUSTOM" box, then enter -20.00% in the "Labor" field then click the "Process" button.

If you want to double the cost of your material and labor, check the "Change guide type to CUSTOM" box, then enter 100.00% in the "Material" and "Labor" fields then click the "Process" button.

If you want to increase the cost of your material, labor, equipment values by 30%, check the "Change guide type to CUSTOM" box, then enter 30.00% in the "Material", "Labor", and "Equipment" fields then click the "Process" button.

If you're concerned about your custom line items ending up

being in their own section on the report, then try the Estimate List report. This report will line up all line items by their line item number.

If you want to change a single line item (in your estimate) into a custom line item (instead of using the batch process) you can. Right click on that line item and then choose Line I tem Tools → Change to Custom Line Item. You won't see anything happen. But now you can open that line item and it will be in custom mode. Everything on top (including the material, labor, equipment costs) will be unlocked so that you can make changes.

Q & A Corner

Q: Okay, so we let you do a Data Backup, a Maintenance Backup (MBU), and a Contract Backup (CBU). Which backup do I do when?

A: A Data Backup is the most important backup you can do! This includes projects, your estimates, and line items. It backs up everything in your data folder. Please do not assume someone else is doing this! Sometimes your IT folks set up automatic backups on the server, but that is not always the case. If you are on a stand-alone machine, it is even less likely anyone else is backing up your data. How much you are using e4Clicks determines how often you would want to back up. You may want to keep your last several backups before you begin overwriting them.

A Maintenance Backup is basically a backup of your licensing information. This simply lets us verify your license information and then update it as necessary. These are most commonly run at the beginning of the year when you renew your license. These are shared with us, so we can extend

your license. A Contract Backup only includes your contract information. This includes your totaling components, contractors, contracts, and the like.
